Assignment of oil and gas Mining Lease.

THIS INSTRUMENT made and entered into this 17th day of May, 1910, by and between Hugh McDivitt, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, first party, and George W. Adams, and Charles M. Adams, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, second parties, WITNESSETH:

That, whereas, on February 23, 1910, Henry Wood as Guardian of Ora Wood, a minor, made, executed and delivered to W. H. Dodd, an oil and gas mining lease covering the following described land in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

The W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 16, Township 20, North, Range 13 East of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing 80 acres, which said lease was filed for record and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in Book 79, Page 247; and

Whereas, on the 7th day of April, 1910, the said W. H. NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty (\$150.00) dollars cash in hand, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said first party Hugh McDivitt hereby sells, assigns, transfers and conveys unto the second parties, George W. Adams, and Charles M. Adams, an undivided one eighth interest, being an one fourth interest in and to the one half interest of said first party in and to the aforesaid oil and
