ORDER CONFIRMING LEASE FOR OIL AND GAS PURPOSES.

It appearing to the court that an order was made by this court on the 18th day of May, 1910, authorizing Emma Coppedge, as the guardian of the estate of the above named Velma G. Coppedge, a minor, to lease the lands of said minor hereinafter described for oil and gas purposes; that on the 18th day of May, 1910, in pursuance of said order, said guardian leased to Dayton Oil & Gas Company, a corporation, the following described real estate of said minor, situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

The SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$; and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$; and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 19, and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 20; and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 19, Township 17 North, range 13 East of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing in all 160 acres more or less.

That said lease was made subject to confirmation by this court; that same was made for a period of five years from its date, and as long thereafter as oil and gas was found in paying quantities; that the said Dayton Oil & Gas Company paid to the said guardian as a bonus therefor the sum of \$160.00; that said lease was fairly made and legally executed; that the said bonus paid therefor by said Dayton Oil & Gas Company and the royalties and conditions imposed thereon on said lease are not disproportionate to the value of said oil and gas lease; that the said guardian in all things proceeded in the execution of said lease as by the statutes provided, and as by said order of court directed and required; and no objections to the confirmation of said lease being made, and the Court being fully advised in the premises.

It is, therefore, Ordered, adjudged and decreed by the court that said oil and gas lease executed by said guardian as aforesaid be, and the same is hereby confirmed approved and declared valid.
