AFFIDAVIT.

Small, being first duly sworn upon his oath says: that he is personally acquainted with David McHodge who executed a quit claim deed to him on the 28th day of October, 1909, conveying unto him, the said A.A. Small, all his right, title and interest in and to the Factory Addition, the Glass Factory Addition and the East Lynn Addition, all of said Additions being additions to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, that said quit claim deed recites that there were two mortgages executed by Albert A. Small to the said David McHodge on the above described property, one of which was dated Feb. 20, 1909 and recorded in Record 46, Page 152 in the records of the Register of deeds, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and the other mortgage was dated March 4, 1909, and recorded in Record 46, page 184 of the records of the Register of deeds of Tulsa County, Oklahoma.
