premises by said lessee his successors or assigns, and further upon the payment of one dollar at any time, by the lessee his successors or assigns, to the lessors their heirs or assigns this agreement may be surrendered for cancellation by paying all rentals due at the time, and, if the lease has been recorded, to execute a release of and deliver same to lessors, their heirs or assigns, after which all payments and liabilities thereafter to accrue u shall cease and determine.

All covenants and agreements herein set forth between the parties hereto shall extend to their successors heirs, executors administrators and assigns.
