(Sec. 17 act of June 30, 1902, 32 Stat. 500)

THIS INDENTURE OF LEASE, made and entered into, in quadruplicate on this Third day of April, A.D. 1906, by and between Menena Grayson, sole heir at law of Silanie Gray, dec'd. of Fry, Indian Territory, party of the first part, and The Warren Company of Bartlesville, of Bartlesville, Indian Territory, party of the second part, under and in pursuance of the provisions of section 17 of the act of Congress approved June 30, 1902, and the regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior thereunder.

Witnesseth; that the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the royalties, covenants, stipulations and conditions hereinafter contained, and hereby agreed to be paid, observed and performed, by the party of the second part, its successors and assigns does hereby demise, grant, and let unto the party of the second part its successors and assigns, for the term of 15 years from date hereof all of the oil deposits and
