

as decreed herein; and the defendants and each of them and all persons claiming through from or under them, or either of them, or claiming or asserting any interest in or to said property or any part thereof be and they are hereby perpetually barred, restrained and enjoined from asserting any right, title, ownership or interest in or to said real estate or any right thereof adversely to the said Creek Nation of Indians and from in any manner interfering with the peaceable and quiet possession of the said Nation in or to the same or any part thereof; and it is further ordered and decreed that The Frisco Oil & Gas Company also within the said twenty days surrender and deliver over to complainant any and all deeds in the possession of the said corporation or any of the officers thereof purporting to be conveyances of any of the said lots or real estate or affecting same.

It is so ordered and decreed.
