premises at the rate of fifty Dollan's per year for the time during which such gas shall be so used, said payments to be made each three months in advance.

The party of the second part agrees to complete a well on said premises within twelve months from the date hereof or pay at the rate of one dollar per acre, in advance for each additional twelve months such completion is delayed from the time above mentioned for the completion of such well until a well is completed, and it is agreed that the completion of such well shall be and operate as a full liquidation of all rent under this provision during the remainder of the term of this lease.

The party of the second part shall have the right a to use gas, oil and water from wells, srings, or streams produced on said land for its operation thereon, excepting water from wells of first party.

When requested by first party, the second party shall bury its pipe lines below plough depth on cultivated land.

No well shall be drilled nearer than 300 feet to the house or ban on said premises. Second party shall pay for da mages caused by it to growing crops on said lands.

The party of the second part shall have the right at any time to remove all machinery and fixtures placed on said premises, including the right to draw and remove casing. All payments which may fall due under this lease may be made direct to William Sunday guardian of said minor, or depositived to his credit in Arkansas Valley Bank at Broken Arrow, Oklahoma.

The party of the second part, its successors and assigns, shall have the right, at any time onpayment of ten dollars to party of the first part his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns to surrender this lease for cancellation after which all payments and liabilities thereafter to accrue under and by virtue of its terms shall cease and determine

All covenants and agreements herein set forth between the parties hereto shall extend to their heirs, executors, administrators successors and assigns.
