# ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said undivided two-thirds interest in said lease and leasehold estate unto the said E.R. Minshall and C.E. Suppes, their heirs and assigns during the remainder of the term of said lease and the life of said estate, subject to the terms and conditions of said lease.
