

## WARRANTY DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That the MAGEE INVESTMENT COMPANY, (a Corporation), organized under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, in consideration of the sum of Twelve Hundred Fifty Dollars, (\$1250<sup>00</sup>) in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Charles A. Wood of Tulsa Oklahoma, his heirs and assigns, the following described real property and premises situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot Twenty-five (25) in Block Two (2)

in Carlton Place Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof, together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereunto belonging, and warrants the title to the same.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said described premises unto the said grantee, his heirs and assigns forever, free, clear and discharged of and from all former grants, charges, taxes, judgments, mortgages and other liens and incumbrances of whatsoever nature.

It is made the condition of this deed that the grantee, his heirs and assigns, shall not use the above described property for other than residence purposes; that the grantee, his heirs and assigns shall not erect thereon a residence which shall cost less than the sum of Two Thousand and 00 Dollars; that no part of said residence shall be within twenty feet of the Carroll avenue street line, nor shall the grantee, his heirs and assigns, erect a barn or garage thereon the rear line of which shall be more than fifteen feet from the alley line.
