This Indenture, Made this Fifteenth day of April A. D. 1910 between E. R. Houston and Augusta Houston (husband & wife) of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and E. R. Kempf and H. P. Anderson of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Eight Thousand 700 and Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part of the second part, their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The south one-half (1/2) of Lot Seven (7) Block One Hundred and six (106) in the City of Tulsa

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said E. R. Houston for his heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents he is lawfully seized in his own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever (Trust assessments) for the year 1910 and subsequent years to be paid by the grantee herein; and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of the second part their heirs and assigns, against said part of the first part their heirs and all and every person, whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same. This conveyance is subject to the perpetual contract between E. R. Houston & Augusta Houston of the 10th day of August 1909 relative to the above lot.
