WITNESSETH, The said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other good and valuable considerations and Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot numbered Seven (7) in Block Numbered One (1) in The Brennan-Reed Addition to the City of Tulsa according to the recorded plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said E. J. Brennan and Jennie E. Brennan, his wife for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;
