 WITNESSETH, The said part of of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$950.00) and Dollars the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part of of the second part, City of Tulsa, Tulsa heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot Four (4) Block Three (3) Oak Grove Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto.
 And said J. de Vries for himself, his heirs, executors and administrators, do est hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents he is lawfully seized in his own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what ever nature and kind, soever except. No house shall be erected on any of the above described lots which shall cost less than \$2000.00 dollars. The above described premises and no part thereof shall ever be sold to any negro.
 And that the said first party will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of of the second part its heirs and assigns, against said part of of the first part his heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
