This Indenture, Made this 25th day of March A. D. 1910.
between Robert H. Shipman and Linal Shipman husband and wife of Tulsa

party of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Sixteen Thousand (\$16,000.00) and Dollars,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,
his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and
State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The north fifty feet of the west Ninety feet of Lot numbered Ten in Block
numbered Eighty eight in Tulsa Oklahoma according to the Government
Plat and survey, allowing for the deviation of the Truise from the true
Meridian.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
any wise appertaining forever.

And said Robert H. Shipman and Linal Shipman for themselves and
for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that
at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance,
in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free,
clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what
nature and kind soever; except, small and paying installments due subsequent to April First
1880 and subject to a first mortgage less in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars due the Morgan Estate
and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, against
said party of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
