## DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY.

STATE OF OKLAHOMA, Tulsa County, ss.

This Indenture, made this 18th day of May, A. D. 1910,  
between J. M. Rodolf and Carlotta Rodolf husband and wife of Tulsa,

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and  
Robert K. Skipman of Tulsa, Tulsa County Oklahoma, party  
of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said part less of the first part, in consideration of the sum of  
Eleven thousand (\$11,000.00) Dollars,  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part of the second part,  
his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and  
State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

I am undivided One 1/2 interest in and to Lot numbered  
Five (5) and the North 5.1 feet of lot numbered Six acre in Block numbered  
Ninety in Tulsa Oklahoma, according to the government plat thereof  
said tract of ground having a frontage of 36.1 feet on Main  
Street and a depth of 140 feet to the Alley with a uniform  
width of 36.1 feet

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in  
any wise appertaining forever.

And said J. M. Rodolf and Carlotta Rodolf for themselves and  
for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the second part, that  
at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance,  
in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free,  
clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what  
nature and kind soever; Except Mortgage due one year past

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of the second part his heirs and assigns, against  
said part less of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
