addition to the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
any wise appertaining forever.

And said A. J. Hodges and Mary J. Hodges
for themselves, heirs, executors or administrators, do... hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that
at the delivery of these presents, lawfully seized in his own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of him and all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free,

clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what
nature and kind soever;

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, against
said party of the first part, their or persons, their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
