WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,
their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and
State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

conveying to Josephine McConnell an undivided one-half interest and to
R. H. Kellough an undivided one-half interest.
The south Forty feet of Lot numbered Seven in Block numbered
Eighty-seven in Tulsa Oklahoma according to the Government plat thereof
allowing for the deviation of the Township from the true Meridian.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
any wise appertaining forever.

And said P. E. Coyne for himself and his
for his heirs, executors or administrators, doe hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said parties of the second part, that
at the delivery of these presents he is lawfully seized in his own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free,
clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what
nature and kind soever, except as mortgaged of \$5,000 and a second mortgage of \$2,500
and excepting paying and receiving installments due subsequent to date first
and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said parties of the second part their heirs and assigns, against
said party of the first part his their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
