This Indenture, Made this 24 day of May, A. D. 1910
between Arthur R. Perryman and Daisy G. Perryman his wife
Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and C. L. Dawson of Tulsa Okla
of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of 18,253.73,
six thousand five hundred and thirty-seven and 35 Dollars,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,
heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and
State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

An undivided one half (½) interest in and to the front 65 feet of Lot
Four (4) and undivided one-half (½) interest in and to the south (40)
feet of Lot Five (5) in Block 69 in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma
fronting on Denver Street and 65 feet deep according to official
map, plan or survey of said City of Tulsa and also an undivided
one-half (½) interest in all the fixtures, machinery and appliances
now in the buildings on the above described premises used in
connection with what is known as the Model Laundry.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
any wise appertaining forever.

And said Arthur R. Perryman and Daisy G. Perryman his wife
and their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that

clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what

of the Register of Deeds of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma,
and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, their heirs and assigns, against
said party of the first part, their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
