DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY.

STATE OF OKLAHOMA, Tulsa County, ss.

This Indenture, Made this 17 day of May A. D. 1910, between James M. Antkist and Ida B. Antkist his wife of Muskogee Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Wesley R. Martin of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said part 1st of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred (300.00) and 20/100 Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part 2d of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The north Twelve and twenty-six hundredths (12.26) acres of Lot Four (4) of Section One (1) Township Sixteen (16) North Range Twelve (12) East.
The above is made subject to an oil and gas lease made on the 11th day of July, 1906 to The Eastern Oil Company of Buffalo New York.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said James M. Antkist and Ida B. Antkist his wife for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part 2d of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents they were lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part 2d of the second part his heirs and assigns, against said part 1st of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
