 of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of  
One Thousand and \$ 1000 Dollars,  
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,  
his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and  
 State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The north 150 feet of Lot one(1), except the north 50 feet thereof and the  
 north 150 feet of the West one-half ( $1\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Lot two(2) except the north  
 50 feet ( $\frac{1}{2}$  50 ft) thereof all in Block One(W), also the north 61  
 feet of Lot Four(4) in Block Sixteen(16) all in Highlands Addition  
 to Tulsa Oklahoma also Lot Four(4) of Block Nine(9) in Highlands  
 second addition to Tulsa Okla the title of both above additions  
 being filed and recorded in the Office of the Recorder in and for  
 the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in  
 any wise appertaining forever.

 for his heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that  
 at the delivery of these presents, he is lawfully seized in his own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance,  
 in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free,  
 clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what  
 nature and kind soever; except as to a certain Gas lease dated Nov 1910

and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, against  
 said party of the first part his their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
