This Indenture, made this 22nd day of March A. D. 1910,
between Delia Squires, John Squires and Annie Squires wife of Lizzie Tiger and
Starwaltie Tiger, husband, Jim Parkinson,
of Cherryell, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and J. S. Haffing
of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
fifteen thousand and no cents and Dollars,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,
his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and
State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Southeast of quarter of section 10 and township 16 sixteen
north, range 21 twelve east, as their interests may appear, that is,
to say Delia Squires conveys and undivided one third interest, John Squires
and Annie Squires convey an undivided one third interest, Lizzie
Tiger and Starwaltie Tiger convey an undivided one twelfth
interest, Jim Parkinson an undivided one twelfth interest
in and to the above described lands, the same being the
allotment of Noah Squires, deceased.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
any wise appertaining forever.

And said Delia Squires, John Squires and Annie Squires, Lizzie Tiger and Starwaltie Tiger, Jim Parkinson
themselves their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that
at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in the right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheri-
tance, in fee simple, of, to and all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free,
clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what
nature and kind soever;

and that they will warrant and forever defend the same unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, against
said party of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
