## DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY.

This Indenture, Made this 9<sup>th</sup> day of June 1910, A. D. 1910,  
between *Rizzie Jefferson, nee Beff* "La Mardaw"

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and *Ethel Davis* of Tulsa, Oklahoma  
of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of (\$800.00)

Eight Hundred and 00/100 Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, doth by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part of the second part,  
*her* heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa  
and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

All my undivided interest in and to the following described land  
to-wit: Lot two (2) or the 1/4 of 11 1/4 of section, sever (D) and the 1/4 of  
the 1/4 of section twenty two (22) and the 1/4 of the 1/4 of section  
twenty three (23) all in township nineteen (19) north, range  
twelve (12) east, the same being the allotment of "Lorraine"  
decreed containing one hundred and sixty (60) acres more or less.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in  
any wise appertaining forever.

And said *Rizzie Jefferson, nee Beff*  
for *her* heirs, executors or administrators, doth hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the second part, that  
at the delivery of these presents *she is* lawfully seized in *her* own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance,  
in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free,  
clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what  
nature and kind soever;

and that *she will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of the second part* *her* heirs and assigns, against  
said part of the first part *her* heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
