 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part of of the second part,  
his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and  
 State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lots number three (3) and four (4) in Block six (6) in  
 North Moreland Addition to the City of Tulsa, as per recorded  
 plat.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in  
 any wise appertaining forever.

 for his heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of of the second part, that  
 at the delivery of these presents he will lawfully seize in his own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance,  
 in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free,  
 clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what

and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of of the second part his heirs and assigns, against  
 said part of of the first part his their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
