COMPARED TO

DEED--GENERAL WARRANTY. STATE OF OKLAHOMA, Tulsa County, ss. This instrument was filed for record on the 11 day of June A. D. 1912, at 1 o'clock P. M., and duly recorded in book on page Fee, \$ in [Signature] Registrar of Deeds.

This Indenture, made this 9th day of June A. D. 1912 between J. J. Sikes and wife Rosa A. Sikes of Broken Arrow, Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and

Alice T. Beaumont of Broken Arrow, Tulsa County, Oklahoma of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Seven thousand and no/100 Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The south half (1/2) of the southeast quarter (1/4) and the south half (1/2) of the northwest quarter (1/4) of the northeast quarter (1/4) and lot number one (1) all of section number one (1) township eighteen (18) north range fourteen (14) east, containing 140 acres more or less

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said J. J. Sikes and his wife Rosa A. Sikes for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents they lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever; except mortgage of two thousand dollars, to H. M. Gellipie and 2 year lease held by the Broken Arrow Loan and Investment Company and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part her heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or claim the same.
