DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY.

This Indenture, Made this eleventh day of June, A. D. 1910,

between W. M. Farmer (also commonly known as W. M. Farmer) a single man,

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and

C. A. Houston of Tulsa, Oklahoma

of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of fifteen thousand (\$15,000.) and Dollars,
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part of the second part,
his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and
 State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The south half of the southeast quarter of section twenty-five (25) and the east half of the northeast quarter, and the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of section thirty-six (36) all in township nineteen (9) north and range twelve (12) east of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing two hundred acres more.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said W. M. Farmer for his heirs, executors or administrators, doth hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents he is lawfully seized in his own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, to and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of the second part his heirs and assigns, against said part of the first part their heirs and all and every person, whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same, for a sum of Twenty-five hundred dollars, (\$25,000.)
