WITNESSETH, The said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, doth by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part of the second part,
her heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and
State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Oklahoma, according to the recorded plats thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
any wise appertaining forever.

for his heirs, executors or administrators, doth hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the second part, that
at the delivery of these presents he is lawfully seized in his own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheri-
tance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free,
clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what
nature and kind soever; except one undivided interest in the lot of Lettie Hardy
which party of the second part hereby assumes; and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of the second part her heirs and assigns, against
said part of the first part their heirs and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
