Quit Claim Deed

This Indenture, Made this 18th day of June A. D. 1912 between S. R. Lewis and W. O. Dickerson of Tulsa

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and W. S. Hall of Tulsa of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One dollar and other valuable considerations and the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The south one-half of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of section thirty six (36) in township twenty (20) north of range twelve (12) east except the rights of way of the Midland Valley and Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Ry. Companies' across the east end thereof, which tract has heretofore been surveyed and platted as the north side addition to City of Tulsa, as will appear from the recorded plat thereof

There is hereby expressly excepted from the above tract, such lots and blocks in said addition as have heretofore been sold and conveyed by S. R. Lewis, Trustee, to various parties

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said parties of the first part hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents lawfully seized in own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part, their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
