This Indenture, Made this 21st day of June A. D. 1912 between W. A. Dickerson and Stella M. Dickerson husband and wife, S. P. Lewis and Elizabeth B. Lewis, husband and wife, all of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Milla Hatcher

of the second part. WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Eighteen Hundred and no/100 Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The southwest quarter of the southeast quarter, and the south one half of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter, and the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section one (1) township twenty (20) north range twelve (12) east, the same being 70 acres, according to the Government survey thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said W. A. Dickerson, Stella M. Dickerson, S. P. Lewis, Elizabeth Lewis for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever; except a mortgage for \$1181.75 dated Feb 1st 1910 and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part her heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
