DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY.

This Indenture, Made this 18th day of June, A. D. 1910,
between Usher Carson and Georgia B. Carson, his wife, of Tulsa, Oklahoma,
Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and T. J. Hutchey of Chandler, Oklahoma
of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
four hundred dollars (\$400.00) and Dollars,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,
his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and
State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The undivided one-eighth (1/8) interest in and to the south half (1/2) of the
northwest quarter (1/4) and the southwest quarter (1/4) of the northeast quarter
(1/4) of section thirty-four (34) township nineteen (19) range twelve (12)

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
any wise appertaining forever.

And said Usher Carson and Georgia B. Carson, his wife,
for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that
at the delivery of these presents, they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance,
in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free,
clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what
nature and kind soever, except a mortgage given to S. L. Fisher on the 17th day of June
1910 for fifteen hundred (\$1500.00) Dollars, due June 17th, 1911,
and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, against
said party of the first part, their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
