WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said parties of the second part,
their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and
State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, as shown by the recorded plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
any wise appertaining forever.

for ~~for~~ their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said parties of the second part, that
