WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,
his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and
State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The south thirty (30) feet of Lot seven (7), and the
North Fifty (50) feet of Lot six (6) in Block Thirty (30) in
the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, as shown by the
government plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
any wise appertaining forever.

And said George W. Groves and Isabel D. Groves
for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that
at the delivery of these presents, they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free,
clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and encumbrances, of what
nature and kind soever; I except us to sever and paying assessments

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part their heirs and assigns, against
said party of the first part the or persons their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
