Seven hundred and twenty dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
