QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

COMPARED

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 11th day of October in the year A. D. 1912, between S. R. Lewis of Tulsa Oklahoma party of the first part, and John L. Swiley and P. C. Cynes parties of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of three hundred (\$300.00) DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said parties of the second part, and to their heirs and assigns, forever, all their right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

South half of northwest quarter of section twenty eight township twenty north range thirteen east, also the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section thirty two township twenty north range thirteen east all in Tulsa County Oklahoma

(Specially releasing said premises from any and all agricultural or grazing leases)

together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging. To have and to hold the above-granted premises unto the said parties of the second part their heirs and assigns, forever.
