

QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 9th day of November in the year A. D. 1910 between Virginia E. Duncan nee Light and Frank E. Duncan her husband and Aden B. Lee unmarried of Tulsa County, Oklahoma parties of the first part, and H. L. Brockman and Henry L. Brockman of Tulsa County, Oklahoma parties of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One dollar and other valuable consideration DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said parties of the second part, and to their heirs and assigns, forever, all their right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The west one-half (1/2) of the East 9 1/2 acres of lot number One (1) of Section Six (6) in Township Nineteen (19) North Range Thirteen (13) East according to the United States Survey thereof  
The East One-half (1/2) of the west 9 1/2 acres of lot four (4) of Section five (5) in Township Nineteen (19) North Range Thirteen (13) East according to the United States Survey thereof

together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging. To have and to hold the above-granted premises unto the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, forever.
