

QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 12th day of November in the year A. D. 1910, between Alice Shutt Joseph Shutt her husband of Tulsa Oklahoma of the first part, and J. B. Wilson of Tulsa Oklahoma of the second part:
