

QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 17th day of November in the year A. D. 1910 between Euphémie Forgue and Gilbert Forgue her husband of the first part, and Thomas Bradley of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said part 1st of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One dollar (\$1.00) DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part 2d of the second part, and to their heirs and assigns, forever, all their right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Beginning on N. line of lot 1, 75 feet west from the N.E. corner, thence N. along lot line 25 feet to a point on said line, thence southerly parallel with the alley line 75 feet to a point on south line of said lot 1, thence easterly along lot line 25 feet to a point on said lot line, thence northerly parallel with alley line to a beginning all in Lot 1 in Block 11 in the City of Tulsa Oklahoma.

together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging. To have and to hold the above-granted premises unto the said part 2d of the second part heirs heirs and assigns, forever.
