QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

COMPARED

WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars, to me duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa

and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: South half of the South West quarter and the west half of the west half of the South East quarter of the South East quarter, and the South West quarter of the South East quarter (less 10 acres right of way of the A. V. & N. R. R.) and 2 1/2 acres, six and seven, and the west 10 acres of Lot Eight, all in Section Fourteen (14) Township Nineteen (19) North Range Eleven (11) East, being the Allotment of Littleton Berryhill, deceased.

together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging. To have and to hold the above-granted premises unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever.
