

## QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 19th day of November in the year A. D. 1910, between J. E. Reed of Wagoner County, in the State of Oklahoma of the first part, and Frank Hollymann of Shelby County, Missouri of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said part 1 of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other valuable considerations DOLLARS to him duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part 2 of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, forever, all right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Wagoner and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The North West two and one one hundredths acres (10.01) of Lot Three (3) of Section one (1) Township Twenty-two (22) North, and Range Twelve (12) East. Less three acres for Skiatook Mission and Less three acres for Cemetery and Less one acre for Church and containing in all (3.01) three and one one hundredths acres.

To Have and To Hold the same together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, to have and to hold the above granted premises unto the said part 2 of the second part heirs and assigns, forever.
