QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 26th day of August in the year A. D. 1910, between

one DOLLARS, to us duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said parties of the second part, and to their heirs and assigns, forever, all our right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

That Portion of Lot Six (6) in Block Two, Landa and there (203) of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the U.S. Government plat thereof, Commencing at the North East Corner of said Lot Six 6 thence Southwardly along the west line of Baltimore place a distance of 108.75 (feet) thence Southwestwardly a distance of 27.2 (feet) thence Northwestwardly a distance of 112.5 (feet) to the place of beginning

together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging. To have and to hold the above-granted premises unto the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, forever.
