## QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this first day of December, in the year A. D. 1910, between  
J. H. M. Lee and his wife, Bessie McLee,  
of the first part, and The McAfee Improvement Company, incorporated under  
the laws of the State of Oklahoma,  
of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One dollar and other valuable consideration DOLLARS,  
to them, duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto  
the said party of the second part, and to their heirs and assigns, forever, all other right, title, interest and estate, both  
at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa  
and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Black Four (4) acres (5) township (13) quartered  
(14) fifteen (15) and the west half (1/2) of Black eleven (11) except  
lot 210, seventeen (17) eighteen (18) nineteen (19) and twenty (20)  
in Capitol Hill Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma  
containing twenty (20) acres more or less according to  
the record plat thereof. The purpose of this instrument  
to convey all our right to and in the above property  
acquired from the United States by United States Land Office  
stated July 3, 1910.

together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging. To have and to hold the above-granted premises unto  
the said party of the second part their heirs and assigns, forever.
