QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 7th day of January in the year A. D. 1911 between Orville S. Booth and Ada L. Booth, husband and wife of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, parties of of the first part, and Virginia E. Quinn (nee Light) and Adam B. Ice of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, parties of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty (\$150.) DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said parties of the second part, and to their heirs and assigns, forever, all their right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The east one-half (1/2) of the east nine and sixty six hundredths (9.66) acres, of lot number one (1) of section six (6) in township nineteen (19) north range thirteen (13) east, according to the United States Government survey thereof, and
The west one-half (1/2) of the east nine and seventy nine hundredths (9.79) acres of lot number four (4) of section five (5) in township nineteen (19) north range thirteen (13) east, according to the United States Government survey thereof.

together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging. To have and to hold the above-granted premises unto the said parties of the second part their heirs and assigns, forever.
