

## QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

COMPARED

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 6th day of June in the year A. D. 1922 between Charles Haley and Georgia Haley, husband and wife of the first part, and Jane H. Cliphant of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said part 1 of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Twenty DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part 2 of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, forever, all our right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The South half of the North West Quarter and Lot No. Four (4) of Section Eight (8) and Lot No. Five (5) in Section Four (4) of Township Nineteen (19) Range Twelve (12) East and Lot two (2) Section Nine (9) Township Nineteen of Range Twelve (12) and Lot Six (6) Section three (3) in Township Nineteen of Range Thirteen East. The same being the undivided interest of E. L. Harrison and wife, heirs at law of Henry Harrison, deceased

together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging. To have and to hold the above-granted premises unto the said part 2 of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever.
