QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 11th day of October in the year A. D. 1910 between David M. Hodge and Nellie Hodge his wife of Tulea County in the State of Oklahoma of the first part and George B. Small of Tulea County, in the State of Oklahoma of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One DOLLAR, to them duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, forever, all their right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulea and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot ten (10) and eleven (11) and the northeast quarter (1/4) of the southwest quarter of section six (6) township thirteen (13) north range the base east of the Indian base and meridian, according to the government survey thereof, except a track of land described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the northeast (1/4) corner of said southwest quarter (1/4) thence south ten hundred and forty three and five tenths (143.5) feet, thence east two hundred thirty eight and seven tenths (238.7) feet to the north four hundred seventy and five tenths (470.5) feet thence east one hundred seventy eight and seven tenths (178.7) feet, thence north six hundred twenty six and one tenth (626.1) feet, thence west four hundred seventy and four tenths (470.4) feet to point of beginning, and excepting further the following described tract of land to-wit: Beginning at a point two hundred (200) feet west of the northeast (1/4) corner of said lot eleven (11) thence south four hundred forty and four tenths (440.4) feet, thence west two hundred seventy six (276) feet, thence north four hundred forty and four tenths (440.4) feet, thence east two hundred seventy six (276) feet to point of beginning, and excepting further that portion of said above described land lying north and east of the M. & T. Railroad Company's right of ways

together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging. To have and to hold the above-granted premises unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever.
