

QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 8th day of February in the year A. D. 1911 between Alvin T. Hodge and Mary J. Hodge his wife of Council, Oklahoma of the first part, and Anna L. Taylor of Tulsa, Oklahoma

of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other good and valuable considerations DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, and to her heirs and assigns, forever, all their right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

All of Lot Six (6) in Block Five (5) in Hodge addition to the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, formerly the town of Tulsa, Indian Territory.

This deed is in connection of a certain deed including the above described real property executed by Alvin T. Hodge and Mary J. Hodge his wife to Thomas E. Smiley conveying property including said real property dated January 4-1907 & Recorded January 8-1907, in Book 5 Page 121 of the records of Tulsa County, Oklahoma

together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging. To have and to hold the above-granted premises unto the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns, forever.
