## QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 1 day of May, in the year A. D. 1919, between

WITNESSETH, That the said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of  
Three Hundred fifty (\$350.00) DOLLARS,  
to them, duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto  
the said part of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, forever, all their right, title, interest and estate, both  
at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa  
and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

South half of the southwest quarter and the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter and the west half of the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter (S. 2, sec. 4, and Sec. 5, sec. 4, and W. 1/4, sec. 4, sec. 4), less than (a) acre  
on N. 1/4, sec. 4, right of way) and one-half acre of land (6-6-7) and one-half acre  
of Section (D) in said section fourteen (14) townships, sixteen (16) roads, range  
Eleven (11) acres, containing 16a 42 per cent more or less and being all the  
allotment of Littleton Berryfield, deceased.

the said part of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever.
