## QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 15th day of February in the year A. D. 1911 between W. N. Patterson

of the first part, and Henry Henderson

of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said part y of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) DOLLARS, to him duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do ed hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part y of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: An undivided  $\frac{1}{2}$  interest in the following described land: the West one-half of the northwest quarter of the north east quarter, and the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter, and the north one-half of the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section Sixteen (16), Township Twenty (20) North, Range Thirteen (13) East.

The intention of this deed is to only transfer the interest in the land that was conveyed to me by Henry Henderson by his deed dated March 24th 1910 and conveying  $\frac{1}{2}$  interest in the above described land.
