

COMPARED QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

THIS INSTRUMENT, Made this 17 day of June, in the year A. D. 1910, between Ed Egan and Bada Egan his wife and James Egan and Nina Egan his wife of the first part, and Eugenia Watson of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One dollar and other valuable consideration DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said parties of the second part, and to their heirs and assigns, forever, all their right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The North East one fourth (NE 1/4) of the North West fourth (NW 1/4) and the West one half (W 1/2) of the South East one fourth (SE 1/4) of the North West one fourth (NW 1/4) and the North east one fourth (NE 1/4) of the South east one fourth (SE 1/4) of the North West one fourth (NW 1/4) of Section Twenty seven (27) Township Twenty one (21) Range thirteen East (13 E)

together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging. To have and to hold the above-granted premises unto the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, forever.
