## QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 15<sup>th</sup> day of June in the year A. D. 1910 Between

 to him duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto  
 the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, forever, all his right, title, interest and estate, both  
 at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa  
 and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The north west quarter of Section Twenty (20) and the North west quarter of Section (15) of Township (13) nineteen north Range (14) East Tulsa County Oklahoma

The interest herein conveyed is all the right title or interest the grantor acquired from L. G. Vance by deed of record from said Vance to grantor Thomas J. Dawson and to the allotment of Arthur Painter

No part of the land herein conveyed was ever used as a homestead by grantor

together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging. To have and to hold the above-granted premises unto  
 the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever.
