QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

to it duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto
the said part y of the second part, and to its heirs and assigns, forever, all its right, title, interest and estate, both
at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa
and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

to convey all the unoccupied lots as of this date which had heretofore been

embracing all the above described Sub-division lying south
of the Frisco Right-of-Way, and all that part of the above described
sub-division lying north of the Frisco Right-of-Way

together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging. To have and to hold the above-granted premises unto
the said part y of the second part its heirs and assigns, forever.
