

QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 21st day of June in the year A. D. 1912 between Mary E. Haigh and J. J. Haigh of the City of Tulsa State of Oklahoma of the first part, and J. H. Holloway of the City of Tulsa State of Oklahoma of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, forever, all their right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Beginning at a point forty five (45) feet South from the line between Lots One (1) and Two (2) in Block Eleven (11) of the City of Tulsa Oklahoma according to the Original plat thereof on Denver Avenue thence West sixty five (65) feet parallel with the line established forty five (45) feet South of Lot one (1) in said Block Eleven (11) thence South five (5) feet thence East fifty five (55) feet to Denver Avenue thence North five (5) feet to place of beginning

This Quit Claim Deed is given by the grantors herein to release all right title and interest in the above described premises that they may have by virtue of a provision in a certain Warranty Deed made by the grantor herein to said grantors herein on the Twenty-ninth day of July 1909

together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging. To have and to hold the above-granted premises unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever.
