QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 18 day of May in the year A. D. 1911 between

The easterly sixty-two (62) feet of lot four (4) in block eighty-one (81) in Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the government survey and plat thereof

together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging. To have and to hold the above-granted premises unto the said part of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever.
